The California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA), together with the Imperial County Agricultural Commissioner and the University of California Cooperative Extension (UCCE) are hosting a Red Palm Weevil (RPW) informational meeting. The goal of this meeting is to brief you on the current RPW status in Laguna Beach (Orange County), together with providing an overview of the pests' biology/identification; the meeting agenda is below.

Worldwide, the Red Palm Weevil is considered one of the most destructive pests of palms. A RPW discovery on a residential palm in Laguna Beach represents the first time this beetle has been detected in the United States. The presence of the RPW in California represents a serious threat to landscape palms and to the date palm industry.

Because you are an important member of California's pest surveillance system, your participation in this meeting is important as we want to educate you with the most current information available to date.
